BOOK FAIR ORGANIZER BOOK FAIR ORGANIZER: GEORGIAN PUBLISHERS AND BOOKSELLERS ASSOCIATION

Georgian Publishers and Booksellers Association was founded in 1997 and it became a member of the International Publishers Association (IPA) in 2007. Today, approximately 90% of all the book publishers and booksellers registered in Georgia are members of the association. The association defines and protects interests and author rights of this sector, and it also guarantees freedom of press in the publishing industry. In order to improve conditions in this field, professional ethics code and legislative initiatives were created by the association. Tbilisi International Book Fair is organized annually by Georgian Publishers and Booksellers Association, 2018 being its 20th anniversary. It is one of the most popular cultural events in Georgia. The association regularly carries out and manages projects and events such as Tbilisi New Year Book Fair, International Book and Author Rights Day in Georgia, World Read Aloud Day in Georgia, Georgian national stand at the Frankfurter Buchmesse, Georgias national stand at London Book Fair, voucherization project of public libraries and Books in Print (www.booksinprint.ge). Apart from this Georgian Publishers and Booksellers Association also organizes professional seminars and workshops for Georgian publishers and booksellers and local book fairs all around Georgia. The association also participates in various international festivals. Main goal of Georgian Publishers and Booksellers Association is to assist in development of the publishing sector in Georgia and popularize reading.



HISTORY OF THE TBILISI INTERNATIONAL BOOK FAIR

The 20th annual Tbilisi International Book Fair is taking place from May 31 to June 3 in Pavilions 11 and 6 of Expo Georgia and is organized by Georgian Publishers and Booksellers Association. This Fair has taken place annually since 1998 and is one of the small number of cultural events gaining a growing interest from the society. It is notable that the number of festival visitors has exceeded 60K in past years. The goal of the Tbilisi International Book Fair is to popularize reading in Georgia, regionalize the book market and assist with development of the publishing sector. Over the years, Tbilisi International Book Fair has contributed in improving literacy in Georgia, indicated by the constantly growing number of festival attendees, media outlets, and new participants. Georgian and foreign publishers, embassies of various countries, state museums and institutes, international organizations and foundations are represented as annual participants at the Tbilisi International Book Fair. Foreign writers attend the book fair as guests of honor every year. The guests of honor for the 2018 Festival will be: Holly Smale, author of the international bestseller Geek Girl; modern Russian writer and playwright Vladimir Sorokin; Bernhard L. Mohr; writer, journalist, and editor at the leading Norwegian publishing house "Cappelen Damm" and Nino Kharatishvili, writer, playwright recognized in Germany. The focus country for the 2018 Tbilisi International Book Fair will be Germany. For the first time in the history, Frankfurter Buchmesse will be the participant of the book fair. They are visiting Tbilisi with a large delegation and will be presented with an own stand in Pavilion 11. The book fair is hosting organizers of Frankfurter Buchmesse, German publishers and three modern authors - Ulla Lenze, Olga Grjaznowa, and Katja Petrowskaja. Members of the delegation will participate in events and meet with readers. The official opening of the book fair will be attended by Jurgen Boss, president of the Frankfurter Buchmesse.

Book Fair is the primary part of the event. Main purpose of the participation of Georgian publishers and booksellers in the book fair is to offer books, auxiliary materials, and book accessories to visitors at special discounts, as well as special gift packages. Many activities related to books, literature, writing and publishing business are brought together by the Tbilisi International Book Fair – presentations of new books and authors by publishers, public readings, meetings and discussions with participation of authors, presentation of the guests of honor, literary prizes, professional seminars and conferences. In connection with the celebratory date, this year the book fair will take up two pavilions at Expo Georgia (11 and 6). Publishing sector and different organizations will be represented in a full scale in Pavilion 11. As for the children's section – book fair is preparing a surprise for young audience this year. Young readers will be hosted in Pavilion 6 and will have a chance to have a look at and purchase children's books within one space, attend events organized especially for them and visit a corner set up designed for their enjoyment.

This year, the Tbilisi International Book Fair is coming out with yet one more novelty. Over the course of three days (June 1-3), book fair will be hosted by 25 Georgian film and theater actors in Pavilion 11. They will present books and lead public readings.

GUESTS OF HONOR OF TBILISI 20TH INTERNATIONAL BOOK FAIR



Holly Smale

A British writer born in England. She studied at Bristol University and worked as an English language teacher in Japan. In 2013 her first and extremely successful book Geek Girl was published, which earned many awards. Her second book Model Misfit was published in the same year, which she had written while in Japan. Holly Smale has written six books for teenagers. She received the Waterstones Children's Book Prize and the Leeds Book Award in 2014. Her most recent book Forever Geek was published in 2017.

Vladimir Sorokin

Being the most well-known modern Russian writer and playwright, Vladimir Sorokin is the author of many novels and plays. He has received the most important national or international literary awards. His books, currently translated into dozens of languages, were banned during the Soviet period and were only published for the first time in Russia in 1989. Vladimir Sorokin once again became a victim of censorship in Russia when a youth movement associated with Vladimer Putin began a massive campaign against the writer and members of so-called patriotic, Orthodox organizations publicly burned his books. In connection with the writer>s visit, Intelekti Publishing has published his most recent work Blizzard (translator: Sergo Tsurtsumia).



Bernhard L. Mohr

A Norwegian writer, journalist, and editor at Cappelen Damm, Bernhard L. Mohr was born in 1978. He traveled to Georgia in 2015 and later on published an article regarding the Georgian occupied territories in the Norwegian press. His second article was published in the Norwegian literary magazine Vinduet regarding modern Georgian literary processes. Bernhard Mohr>s documentary novel Why Russians Elect Putin was published in 2017. The publication of the Georgian translation of the book was made by Artanuji Publishing to coincide with the authorys visit. Bernhard Mohr lived in Moscow during the years 2006-2008 and worked as a correspondent at a local newspaper. At that time, many still believed that Russia>s democratic development was possible and even to be expected. Ten years later after the Russian-Ukrainian War, Bernhard Mohr once again returned to Russia, this time in order to get some answers to some crucial questions: "Why do Russians support a system which constantly resembles a growing repressive regime in Western eyes?"





Nino Kharatishvili

Nino Kharatishvili is an acclaimed writer, playwright, and theater director in Germany. She was born in 1983 in Tbilisi. Her plays are successfully staged in Vienna, Moscow, Weissbaden, Berlin, Hamburg, etc. Georgian readers are already quite familiar with Nino Kharatis-hvili>s first novels Zhuzha and My Favorite Doppelganger, as well as a collection of plays The Year of My Terrible Happiness, which was translated and published in recent years by Intelekti Publishing. In September 2018 however, Intelekti will publish her third, 1,300-page novel The Eighth Life (To Brilka), which was published in 2014 in Germany and right then became a bestseller. This is a hundred-year saga of one Georgian family which earned great praise from German critics and readers. Speigel however considered this work "the novel of 2014". It was written in the German media that Nino Kharatishvili had established herself as one of the most intriguing and distinguished writers of her generation.



The Focus Country of the 20^{th} Tbilisi International Book Fair — GERMANY

Georgia will be presented as the guest of honor in October 2018 at the Frankfurter Buchmesse. This was the reason for Germany being chosen as the focus country at the Tbilisi International Book Fair this year by Georgian Publishers and Booksellers Association.

The Frankfurter Buchmesse, three German authors, and two German publishers are special guests at the 20th Tbilisi International Book Fair.

The five-day Frankfurter Buchmesse is the largest book fair in the world and has up to half a million attendees. Thousands of publishers, literary agents, writers, book merchants, and journalists participate in it annually. Each year there are hundreds of thousands of titles presented at the fair.



Katja Petrowskaja

Katja Petrowskaja was in 1970 in Kyiv. The Ukrainian author studied literary sciences and Slavic studies in Tartu, Estonia, whereas she received her PhD in Russian literature in Moscow. Katja moved to Germany in 1999 and began working in various Russian and German media groups. After she published her work Vielleicht Esther she was given the Ingeborg Bachmann Prize in 2013. Vielleicht Esther has been awarded numerous prizes and has been translated into 20 languages. The author is currently a reviewer for Frankfurter Allgemeine Sonntagszeitu, a leading Frankfurt newspaper.



Stefan Weidle is a translator, lecturer, and publisher born in 1953 in Stuttgart. Over a certain period he was even involved in the journalism business. In 1994 however, he founded his own publishing company in Bonn. Weidle has accumulated many awards, including the Kurt Wolff (2005) and Karl Heinz Zillmer (2000) prizes. For a period of many years, he was director of the Kurt Wolff Foundation. He currently lives in Bonn and Berlin.

Ulla Lenze

Ulla Lenze was born in 1973. Her debut took place in 2003 with the greatly acclaimed novel Schwester und Brüder. The authors most recent novels are Der kleine Rest des Todes (2012) and Dieendlose Stadt (2015). Ulla Lenze has been in Damascus, Mumbai, Istanbul, and Venice as a Writer-in-Residence. Apart from some texts written for a cultural segment on German radio, the author also prepared creative travel reports for various well-known magazines such as DIE ZIET, NZZ, FAZ, and TAZ. In 2016, the author received the literary prize - Literaturpreis des Kulturkreises der deutschen Wirtschaft – for her creative work.





Olga Grjasnowa

Olga Grjasnowa was born in 1984 in Baku, the capital of Azerbaijan. She has lived abroad for a long time, particularly in Poland, Russia, Israel, and Turkey. Her work Der Russe ist einer, der Birken liebt has received numerous awards. The debut of her next novel Die juristische Unschärfe einer Ehe took place in 2014. Both works have been cast as theatrical presentations and some films are currently being made based on the plots. Olga wrote yet another novel Gott ist nicht schüchtern in 2017. Her monologue Abstruz was staged in May 2018 at the Frankfurt theater Schauspiel Frankfurt.



Philip Musser

An architect and publisher by profession, Dr. Philip Musser was born in 1969. When studying at the Department of Architecture at Berlin Technical University, he was a Konrad Adenauer grant recipient. He underwent his apprenticeship at WDR (Cologne) and Bauwelt. Dr. Musser pursued editorial work at the Zurich newspaper Neue Züricher Zeitung. He received his next degree in Architecture History and Theory at the Zurich Federal Institute. In 2015 he was awarded his doctorate for the work Soviet Union Architecture Between Stalin and the Glasnost.
